

Fire Safety Information



FIRE SAFETY All buildings can have fires. Plan what to do when you check in. You won't have time to plan during a fire.

First, find two exits nearest your room.

Be sure they are unlocked and unblocked. en, count doors between your room and exits so you'll have a reference point if it is smoky.

When you hear an alarm, act, don't investigate.

If you smell smoke, immediately dial the front desk.


If fire is in your room, get out and close the door. Once out, report the fire. If fire is not in your room, leave if you can. First, feel your door. If it's cool, open it slowly and go to the nearest exit. Use stairs and close doors behind you. is keeps smoke from entering stairwell. Crawl in smoke. Fresh air will be at the floor. Take your key so you can go back if you can't use your exits.

If your room door is hot, don't open it. Your room may be the safest place to be. Fill tub with water. Seal all cracks with wet towels and use wet tissue to insulate small openings. If walls get hot, wet with water by using ice bucket or a pan. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Call front desk. Signal at your window. DO NOT BREAK WINDOW. DO NOT PANIC. Help is on the way.



Room Layout



Area Attractions



SUGAR MOUNTAIN

If you've enjoyed the skiing at Sugar Mountain in the past, there's good news: there's even more to enjoy this year. Here's an overview of what's new this season at the resort:

New Grooming Equipment: Sugar is adding two new Kassbohrer Pisten Bully grooming machines for this season. These over-the-snow vehicles, equipped with snow tillers, will allow Sugar to better recondition the snow surface.

Increased Snowmaking: Sugar has long been able to make snow on 100 percent of its slopes, bur this season the resort will be able to cover more terrain and do it faster.

Sugar is installing a new water pump that will increase snowmaking capacity by 33 percent. This will be particularly during the early part of the season and following warm periods during the winter.

Snowboard Park: The park, called Dead End Snowboard Park because it's located on Dead End slope, features a spine gap, table top and rail slide.

Lighting on the Snowboard Park: Snowboard at night! Lights are being installed on the Dead End slope to allow the new snowboard park to be used at night.

HAWKSNEST

As a leader in snow tubing, Hawksnest has taken our snow tubing to new levels of fun. Hawksnest's expanded snow tubing operation will make it the biggest snow tubing operation on the East Coast. Our Snow Tubing resort will now have 4 different areas to snow tube with 20 lanes of fun, lanes will be 400 - 1000 feet long and 2 moving carpet lifts to take you back to the top. Hawksnest has 100% snowmaking and lighting on all lanes to provide the best possible conditions and fun for the whole family. Also, don't forget to enjoy our Coffee Bar, Carolina BBQ and Pizza before, during and after your tubing session. Hawksnest has built the largest zipline course on the east coast with 10 cables and swing bridge. These 10 cables add up to 15 miles of cable riding. The course takes you through the trees, over the trees, over creeks and surrounded by some of the best views in the High country. Zipline riding is an exciting and safe experience for the entire family. By adding the zipline course to Hawksnest, they are able to offer year round family entertainment. SKIBEECH

The Red Baton flies again at Ski Beech! Back in the early days Of the resort, the Red Baron was the best known bar. "It was sort of a center of the place," said Rick Owen.

This season the old bar has reopened as The Red Baron Room, Beech's new full-service snowboard shop. It's located in the Village and offers five brands of clorhing plus over 100 snowboard rentals, a wintersreiger snowboard turing machine and more.

Amid the 'boards, there are some of the things that made the old Red Baron so memorable.

"We have a lot of World War I memorabilia," Owen said. That includes one you can't miss; a whole wing of a plane that hangs from the ceiling.

Snowboarding is growing fast. "Over the past three to four years, the number of snowboarders has doubled ever year," Owen said, "We expect to see that again this year."



Area Attractions



GRANDFATHER MOUNTAIN

The blue ridges of mountains appear through the trees as you wind your way to the top of Grandfather Mountain. It is so quiet that your car seems to be the only sound around. It has the highest peak in the Blue Ridge Mountains, at 5,964 feet.

Grandfather is said to have the oldest rock formations on earth, according to a report by the U.S. Geological Survey. Indians named the mountain, it is said, because it looks like the face of an old man skygazing. Sightseers will be struck by the panoramic views, photo opportunities and surprises like glimpses of black bear cubs or mountain lions.

Hikers will enjoy the 15 to 20 miles of trails in Grandfather's 4,100 acre wilderness area. And, at the top of the mountain, is a spectacular swinging bridge, spanning two peaks.

BLOWING ROCK

A 20-minute ride from Grandfather, bearing northeast on US 221, takes you to Blowing Rock, a 3,000 foot cliff overlooking the Johns River gorge. The fame of Blowing Rock comes from the current of air that flows upward, causing light objects dropped over its side to return.

According to an old legend, a Cherokee brave had fallen in love with a Chickasaw maiden but knew his duty was to return to his tribe. Out of frustration he jumped from the rock, leaving his maiden praying to the Great Spirit for his safe return. One day, the sky reddened and the brave was blown back safely into her arms. Long ago this served to explain why the wind blew upward at the rock, and why snow fell upside down.

HISTORIC VALLE CRUCIS

Nestled high in the Appalachian Mountains of North Carolina is a peaceful rural community that has stayed untouched over the years. When Levi Ives, the second Episcopal bishop of North Carolina, visited the area in the 1840s he looked into the valley from the hillside, noticed three streams forming the shape of a St. Andrew's cross and deemed the location Valle Crucis, Latin for "Vale of the Cross." Pronounced valle crew'sis, the bucolic area was first formally settled over 200 years ago and is a place historians and visitors alike have called "uncommon."

Valle Crucis is North Carolina's first rural historic district and the entire community is officially listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Nationally recognized historic buildings are abound in Valle Crucis, with many like The Baird House (1790), The Mast Farm Inn (1812), the Old Episcopal Mission (1842) and the Mast General Store (1883), restored to their initial splendor and still serving the area today. The Mast General Store opened in 1883 and quickly grew in reputation for carrying everything from

"cradles to caskets." Even today, you'll still find shelves packed with all you might need for life in the 19th century and most ofthis one. Entering this landmark, you'll notice advertising posters untouched since Mr. Mast hung them decades ago, stand at the counter where locals once bartered their good or mail a letter at the community's corner post office. Youmight even discover a few old-timey bargains along the way.




